PRAY FOR CHILDREN WHO HAVE SEEN HARD THINGS. PRAY THAT THEY WILL BE HEALTHY AND HAPPY. PRAY THAT PEOPLE WHO HAVE BEEN HURT WILL NOT HURT OTHERS. PRAY THAT GIRLS AND WOMEN WILL BE LOVED BY THEIR FATHERS AND HUSBANDS.

I will search for the lost. I will bring back those who have wandered away. I will bandage the ones who are hurt. I will make the weak ones stronger. But I will destroy those who are fat and strong. I will take good care of my sheep. I will treat them fairly.

PRAY FOR FAMILIES EVERYWHERE

Some Christians are persecuted for their beliefs. They are treated badly and sometimes forced to leave their homes. Think about what life is like for these families. They might have to live in tents near many other people. They might be sad and sick. It may be hard for their family to have enough food. Think about these things. Then pray.





PRAY FOR FAMILIES. PRAY THAT THEY WILL KNOW GOD'S LOVE. PRAY FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE BEEN KICKED OUT OF THEIR FAMILIES BECAUSE THEY FOLLOW JESUS.

See what amazing love the Father has given us! Because of it, we are called children of God. And that's what we really are! The world doesn't know us because it didn't know him. – I John 3:1

The Lord your God is with you. He is the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you. In his love he will no longer punish you. Instead, he will sing for joy because of you. – Zephaniah 3:17

PRAY FOR PEOPLE WHOSE FAMILY MEMBERS HAVE DIED FROM PERSECUTION.

I am absolutely sure that not even death or life can separate us from God's love. Not even angels or demons, the present or the future, or any powers can separate us. Not even the highest places or the lowest, or anything else in all creation can separate

> us. Nothing at all can ever separate us from God's love. That's because of what Christ Jesus our Lord has done. – Romans 8:38-39

PRAY FOR MOTHERS WHO ARE WORKING HARD TO CARE FOR THEIR FAMILIES. PRAY FOR FATHERS WHO ARE FIGHTING FOR FREEDOM. PRAY FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE BEEN HURT, AND THOSE WITH NO JOB. PRAY THAT FAMILIES CAN RETURN TO THEIR HOMES AND CITIES.

God is our place of safety. He gives us strength. He is always there to help us in times of trouble. – *Psalm 46:1*

Then Asa called out to the Lord his God. He said, "Lord, there isn't anyone like you. You help the weak against the strong. Lord our God, help us. We trust in you. In your name we have come out

to fight against this huge army. Lord, you are our God. Don't let mere human beings win the battle over you." - 2 Chronicles 14:11

The Lord gives strength to his people. The Lord blesses his people with peace. – *Psalm 29:11*
